Decorate Eggs for Easter!











You Will Need:

- box of eggs
- saucepan
- food colouring
- tongs
- heatproof bowls/jars
- vinegar
- glue
- googly eyes
- sharpie pens

To Make:

To decorate your eggs you will first need to hard boil them.

- **1.** With an adult, place your eggs in a saucepan of water on the hob and bring to the boil.
- **2.** Boil on a low heat for 8 to 10 minutes then drain the eggs from the hot water and place them in a bowl of cold water until cool.
- **3.** In your heatproof bowl place 20 drops of food colouring, 1 tsp vinegar and some hot water.

NOTE: If using multiple colours use more than one bowl and repeat this step for the different colours.

4. Using the tongs dip your eggs into the food colouring. Submerge the whole egg or half the egg if dying more than one colour. Feel free to get creative with this stage!

Tip! The longer you dip the bolder the colour will be!

5. When finished with the dye leave your eggs to dry. If using multiple dyes on one egg, leave each colour to dry before adding the next.

Now it's time to decorate your coloured eggs in whatever way you choose.

- **6.** To attach the googly eyes to your egg simply apply a small amount of glue to the back and press onto the egg.
- **7. Decorate!** Create cool patterns, or funny animal/monster faces using the sharpie pens and googly eyes to create a colourful, fun selection of eggs!
